About Luggage

- ▶ Hiking Shoes
- ▶ Sneaker and water shoes
- ▶ DryFit clothes.
- ► Insect Repellent.
- Sunscreen
- ► Medicine necesary for 17 days.
- Hiking Poles (If needed)
- ► Rain Coat
- ▶ Lintern
- ▶ Bath towel
- ▶ Bath suit
- ► Hat, or cap.

Cancelation Policies

- ► First \$500 payment non refundable more due two months before.
- ▶ Second \$500 payment non refundable more due one month before.
- ► Third (balance) payment:
 - o 100% refund 30 days before the expedition
 - o 75% refund 22 days before the expedition
 - o 50% refund 15 days before the expedition
 - o 25% refund 8 days before expedition.
 - o 0% refund 7 days or less before expedition.





Notes

It is the obligation of the participants to be in good health to carry out the 265 km of walking, in case they are not, they must abide by the guide's instructions according to their criteria. Including paying costs such as extra transportation, change of accommodation, and other necessary adjustments.

We recommend training hills as 70% of the hike is up and down.
